2017 Attorney Training
Certification Requirements

To obtain eligibility credit for the 2017 Attorney Training in the Probate Court, attorneys are required to satisfy **all** of the following requirements:

Attend the September 28, 2017 **Afternoon** Attorney Training session offered by the Probate Court.

If you did not attend **any** of the Probate Court Attorney Training Sessions from 1996 - 2016, you must also attend the September 28, 2017 **Morning** Attorney Training session.

Submit a **completed** "Attorney Profile Sheet" provided by the Court in the seminar materials.

Deadline for submission of Attorney Profile Sheets is **October 27, 2017**.

Submit a copy of the "face sheet" (i.e., the declaration page showing a minimum aggregate level of liability coverage of \$250,000) from your malpractice insurance policy.

Deadline for submission of malpractice insurance information is **October 27, 2017**.

Attorneys who otherwise meet the certification requirements but do not submit malpractice insurance information will be eligible for Guardian ad Litem assignments only.
