SUBJECT: Return to Full Capacity Plan Re: Wayne County Sheriff Deputy Assignments to Courts

This Administrative Order facilitates the Third Circuit Court and Wayne County Probate Court's return to full capacity directive from the State Court Administrators Office, Michigan Supreme Court Administrative Order 2020-14, and MCR 8.110(C)(2)(c) and MCR 8.110(C)(3)(i).

This order rescinds and replaces Third Circuit Court Local Administration Order 2020-05J and Wayne County Probate Court Local Administrative Order 2020-04J.

IT IS ORDERED:

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the Wayne County Sheriff Deputies assigned to the Third Circuit Court and the Wayne County Probate Court shall not work overtime, weekends, temporary reassignments, or other assignments at the Wayne County Jail.

There are two situations in which an exception may be granted:

- 1. The Court assigned deputies have received the required number of COVID-19 vaccinations (2 for Pfizer and Moderna and 1 for Johnson & Johnson); or,
- 2. There is medical verification the deputy tested positive for COVID-19 and has since recovered. This would provide the expectation that the deputy has antibodies for the COVID-19 virus.

The Wayne County Sheriff's Administration must verify the status of all assigned deputies under the exceptions.
